- Introduction (Sandwell)

This is the 10th annual Meeting of WInSAR. When WInSAR began we had the following three objectives:

- Permission to share data already purchased or obtained for free among the SENH investigators.
- Permission to share new data that will be purchased or obtained for free among the SENH investigators.
- Write a large proposal to NASA to purchase the ESA archive over say Western North America. The ESA research price is \$400/frame but when you go to higher numbers of frames the price goes up!! Radarsat-\$960 Spotimage-\$792.

Well we have come a long way since the early days.

- We have been able to move the entire group of WInSAR investigators into the CAT 1 research area.
- The current price per scene is 13 euro and we have basically acquired all the available ERS-1/2 and Envisat data in the Western US through GeoEarthScope (17 Tb).
- Our membership is now about 70 total with 54 full members, 4 adjunct I members and 12 adjunct II members.
- We have moved the operations from SCEC to UNAVCO and WInSAR members no longer have to manage the data purchase and archive.
- Our archive now includes RADARSAT-1 data and ALOS data although the bulk of the ALOS data will reside at ASF.
